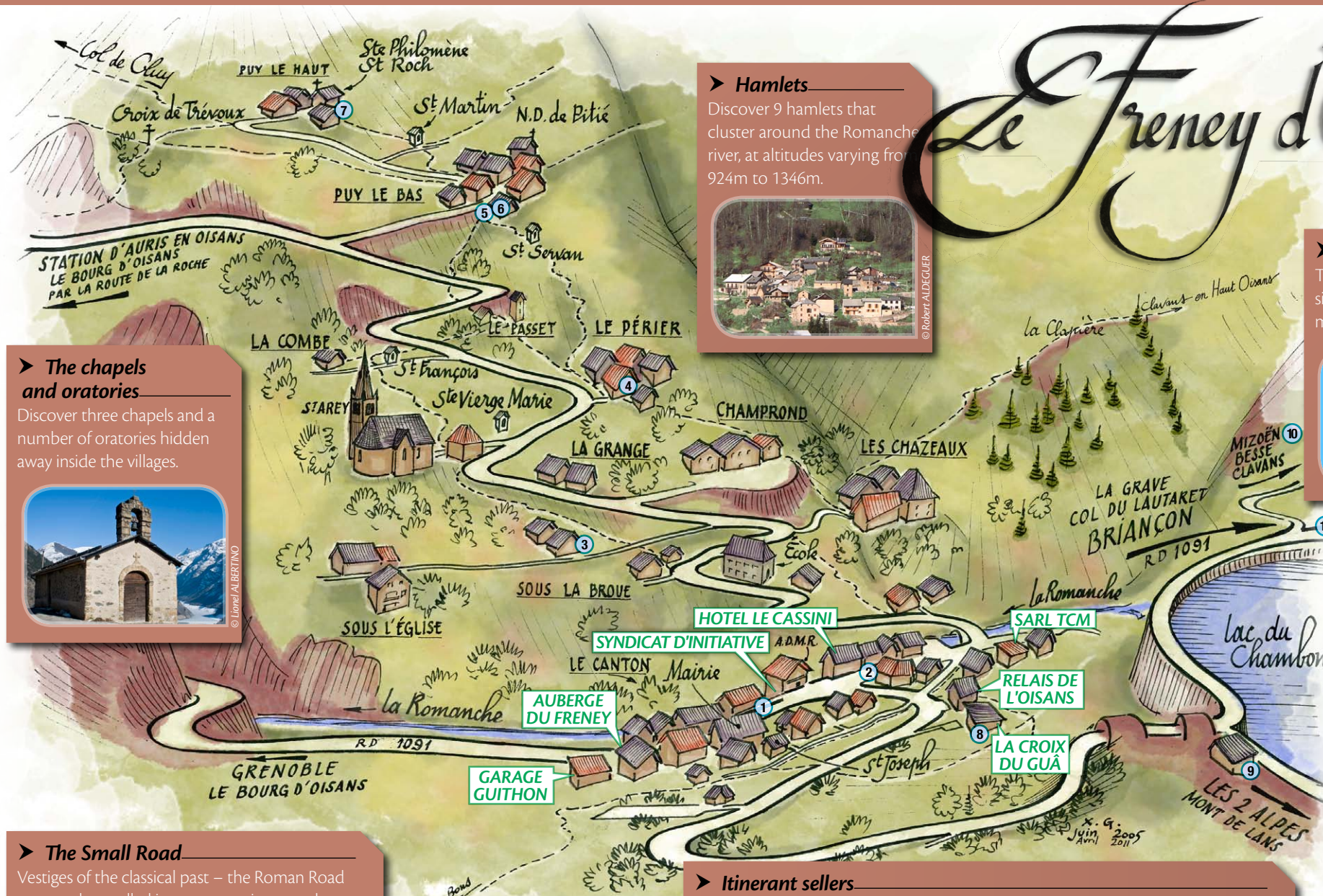
LE FRENEY

The heart of Oisans



► **Le Mount Cassini (2376m)**

When you get to the top, you are rewarded with a 360° panorama that takes in the Ecrins mountain range, including the Meije, Belledone and the Grandes Rousses. A 2-hour climb lets you discover the Oisans in all its splendour in the pure mountain air.



► **Hamlets**

Discover 9 hamlets that cluster around the Romanche river, at altitudes varying from 924m to 1346m.

► **The chapels and oratories**

Discover three chapels and a number of oratories hidden away inside the villages.

► **Lake Chambon dam**

This imposing dam – for many years one of the highest in Europe – has dominated the valley since 1935. Superb views.



► **The Small Road**

Vestiges of the classical past – the Roman Road was much travelled in past centuries – can be found not far from Freney, sheltered by Nature.

► **Itinerant sellers**

In the 18th century peddlers from Freney left the Oisans to travel all France, Europe, even the world, to sell their merchandise. Our valley specialised in spectacles, flowers, seeds and haberdashery.
